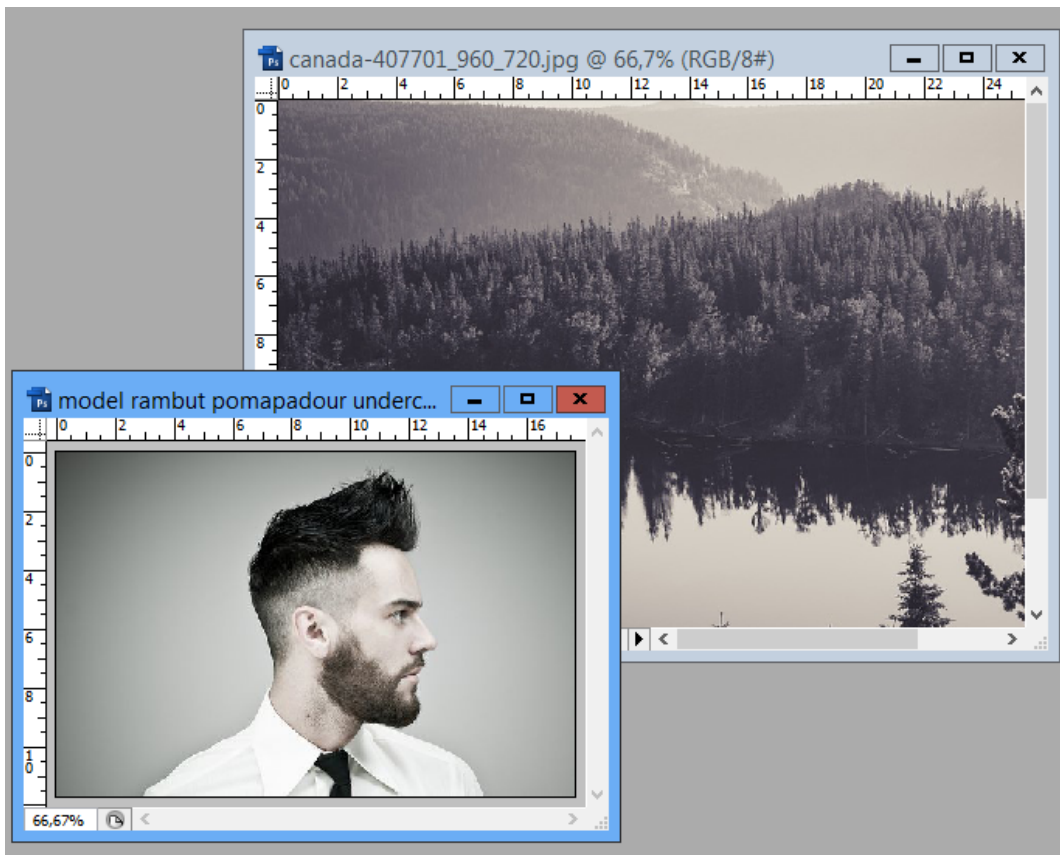
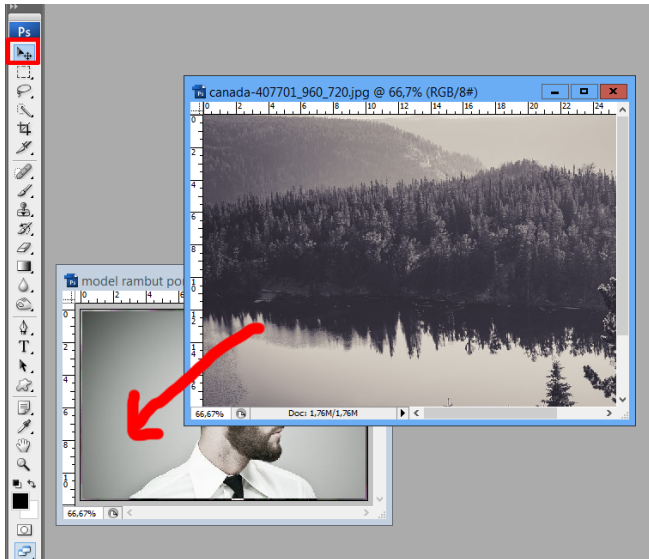


Before we start this tutorial. You must prepare yourselves portrait photos 1/model let the set cool white (can) and 1 photo of the wilderness, whether it's a view of the forest or the city landscape that you are suited for double exposure effect.

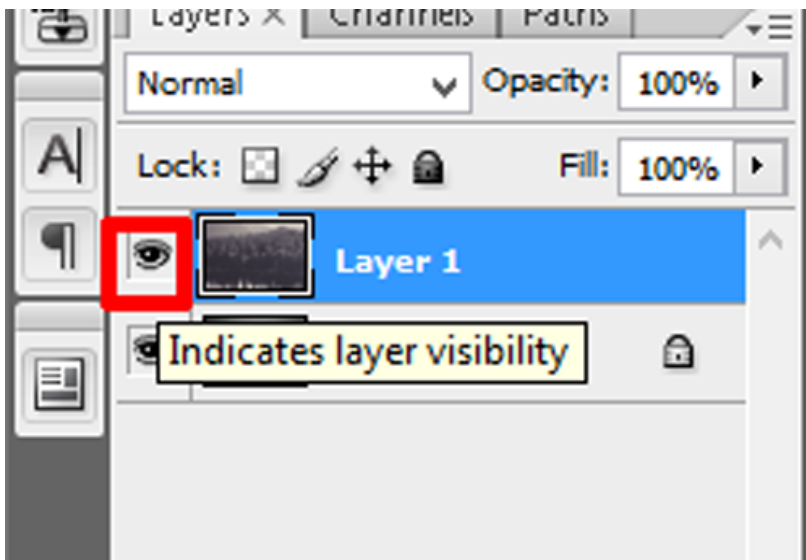
1. Open photoshop.
2. Open the pictures you want to edit the photo and photo model i.e. landscape views, **File>open**



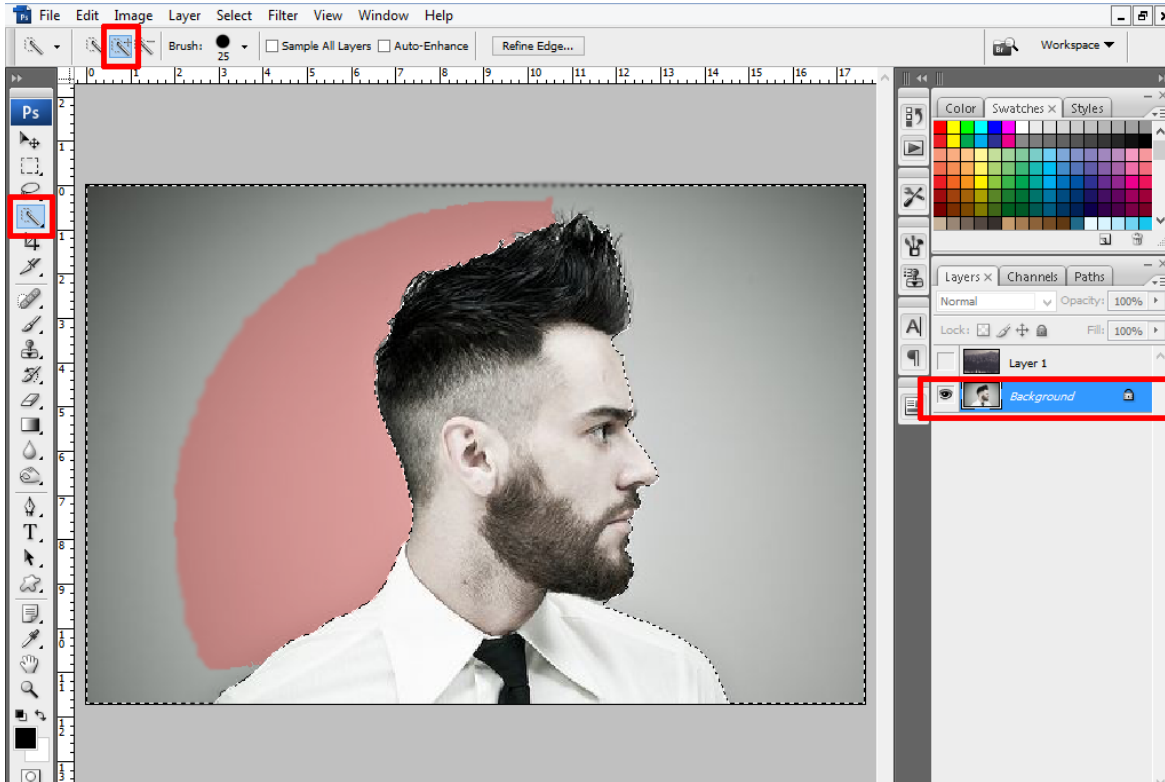
3. Choose the landscape picture, choose **SELECT > ALL**, then **EDIT>COPY**, Then **EDIT>PASTE**, so that you have 2 layers in your portrait picture.



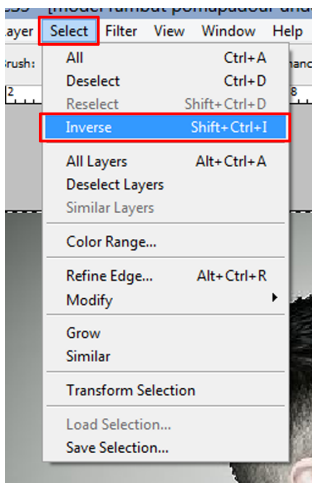
4. As seen in figure below



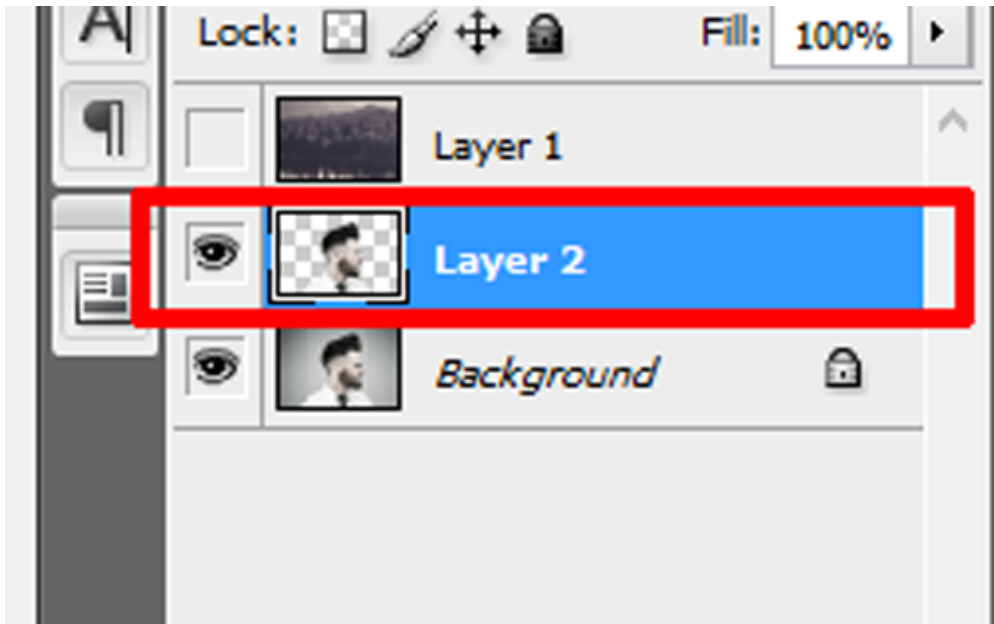
5. Use the **quick selection tool** to select the background.



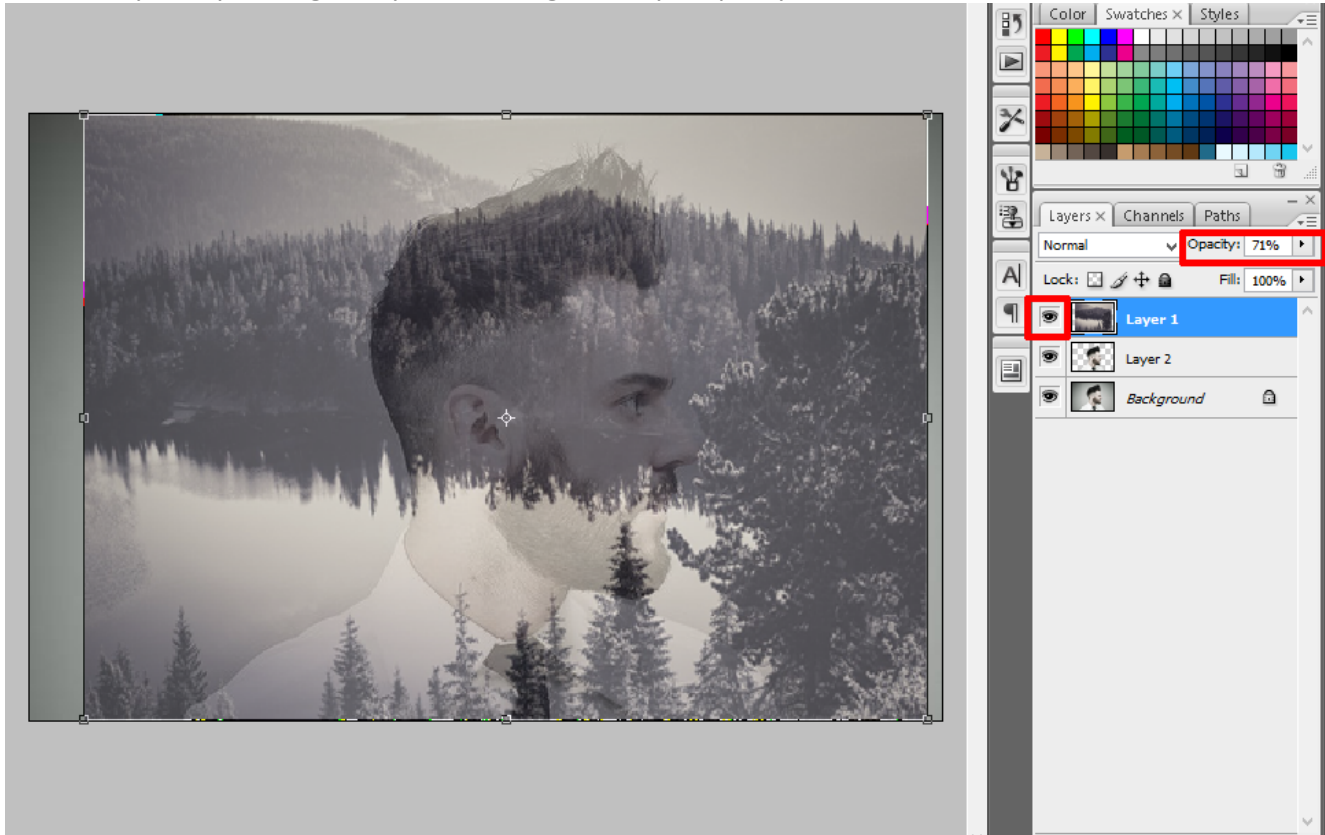
6. From the select menu, choose **SELECT>INVERSE** . Then choose **SELECT>SAVE SELECTION** and name it **PORTRAIT**



7. Duplicate the portrait layer with no background

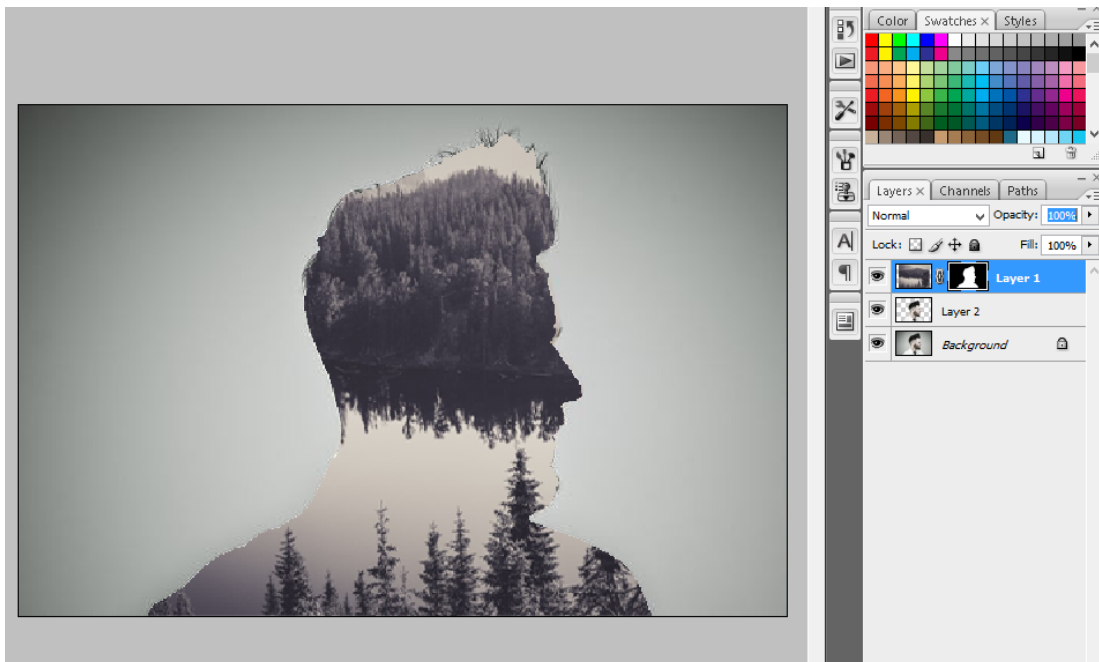
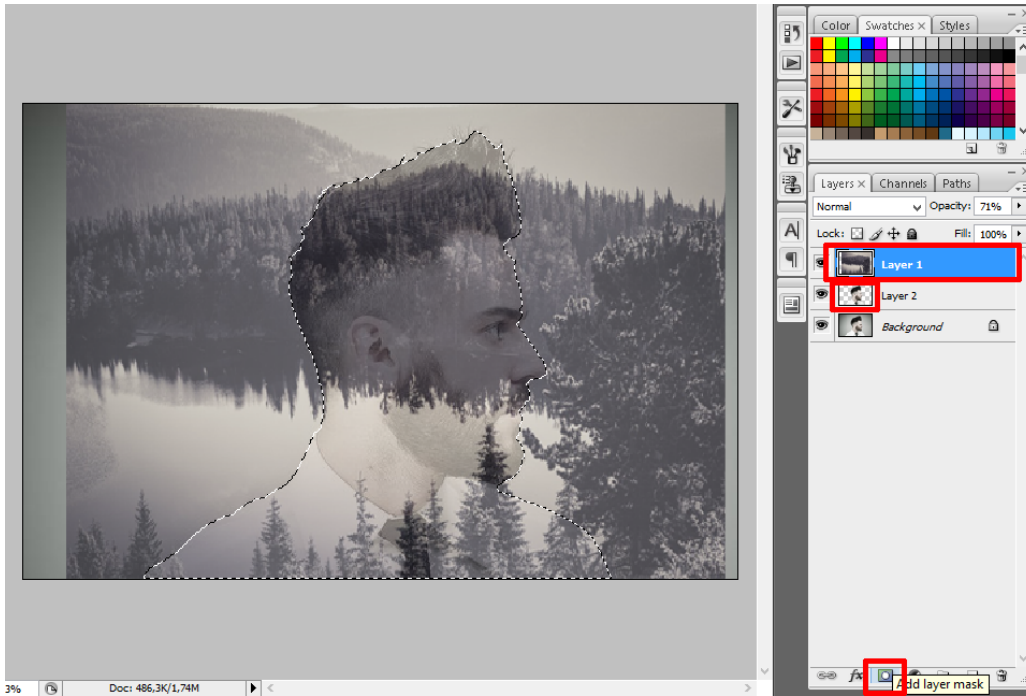


8. Select layer 1 by clicking the eye icon, change the Layer Opacity to 70

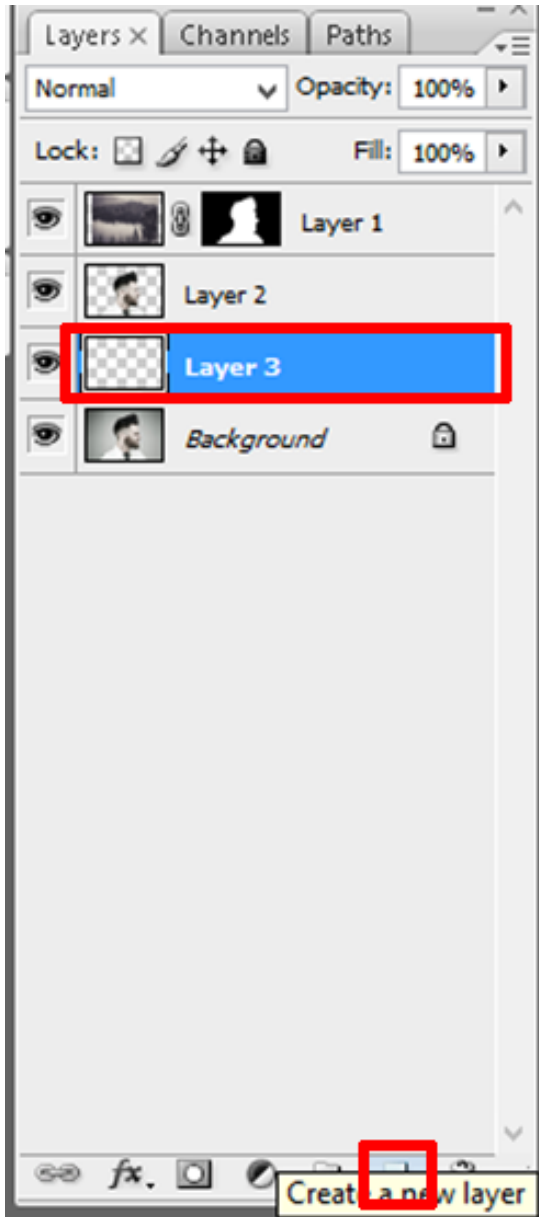




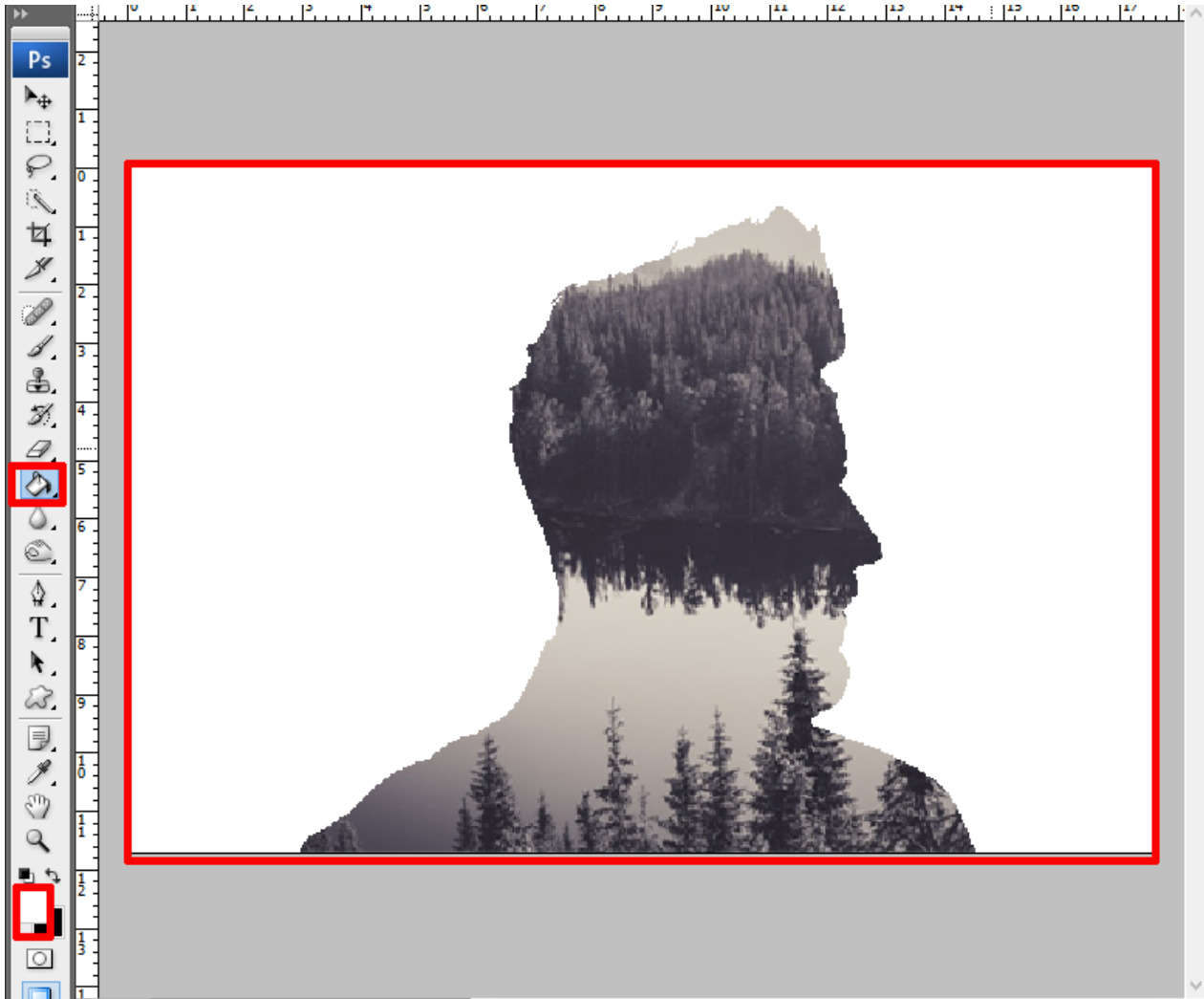
9. From the landscape layer, choose **SELECT>LOAD SELECTION**



10. Then create a new layer

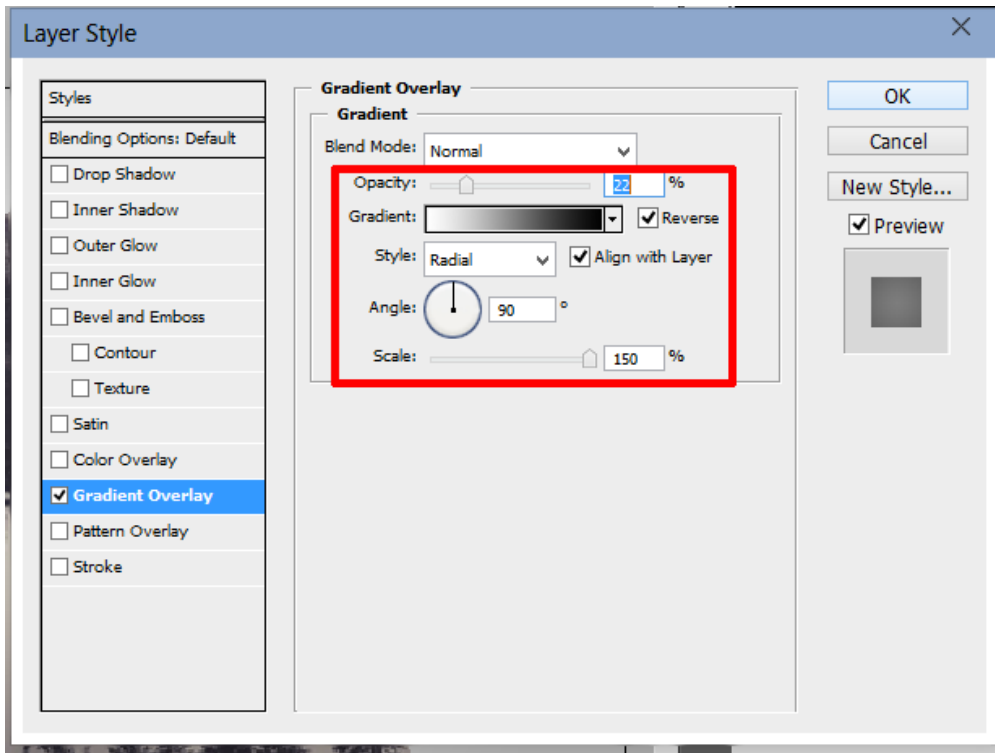


11. Warnai with white color with paint bucket tool

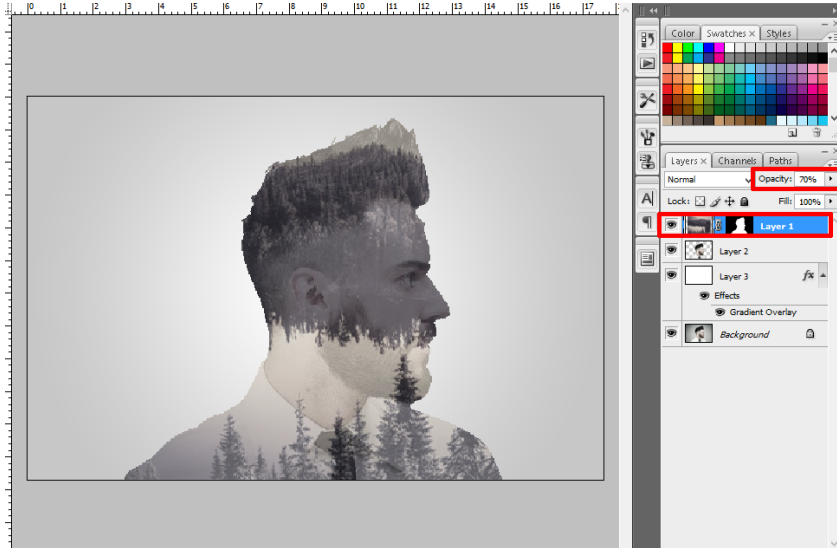




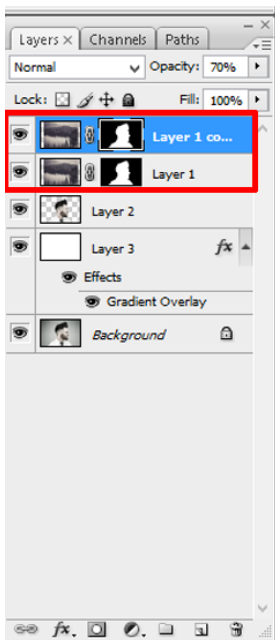
12. Layer style/gradient overlay and then customize with an image below or reply edited pic resolution



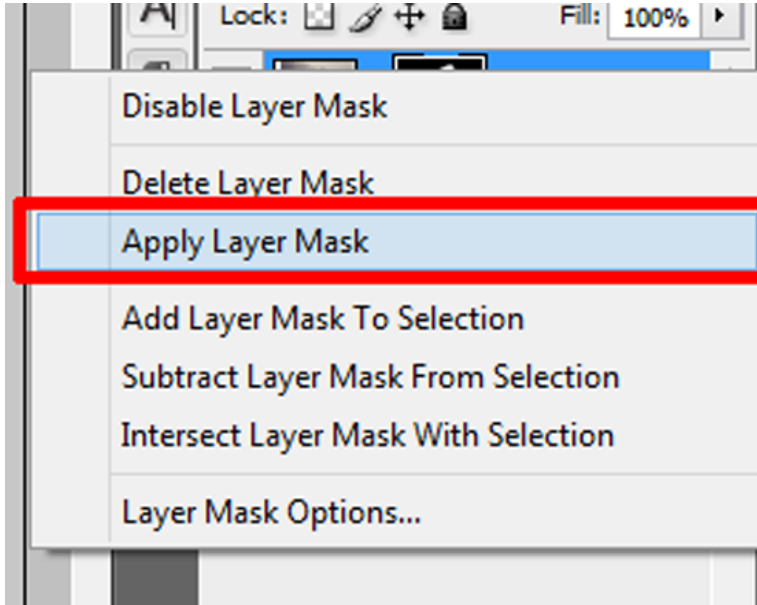
13. After that click the layer1 and change the opacity to 70



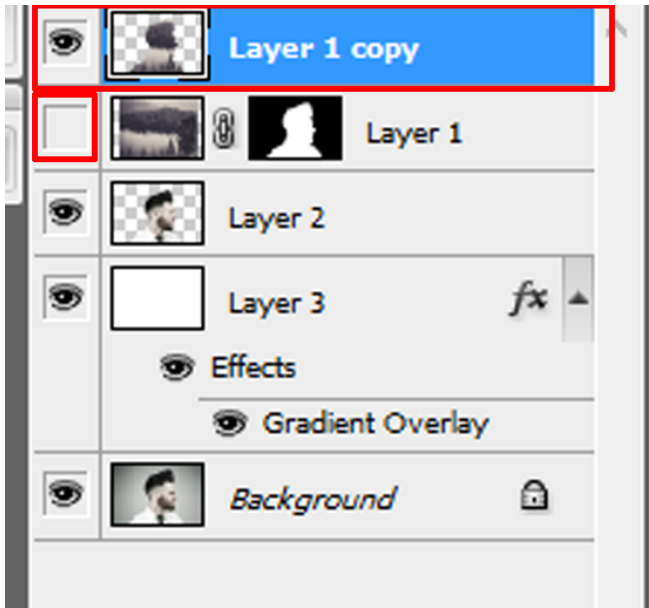
14. Duplicate layer



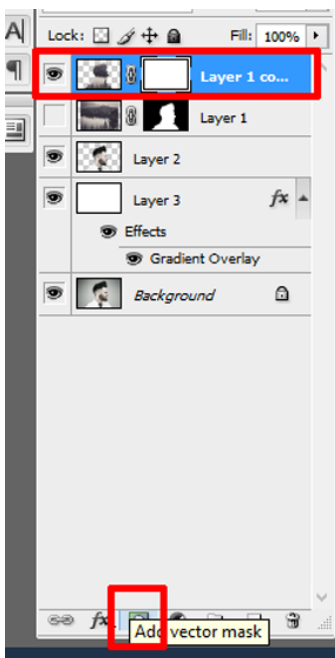
15. Then right-click layer1 copy select the apply layer mask



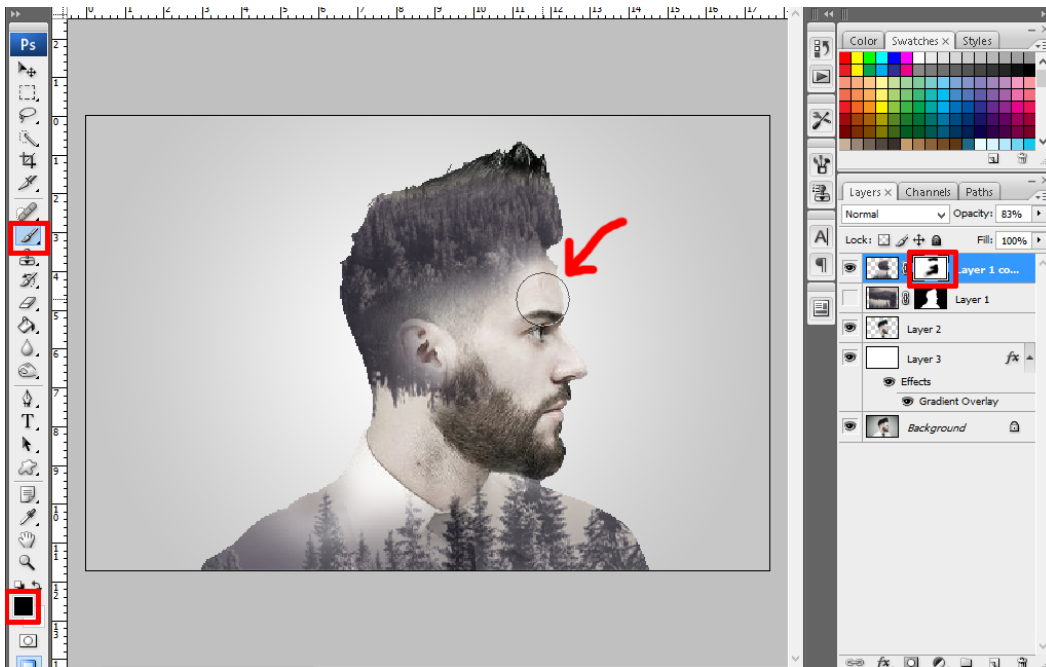
16. Hide layer 1 and click copy layer 1



17 Click the vector mask



18. And then polishing the obverse to remove pic views with brush black color denganhardness 20, do not forget to click on the layer 1 copy the vector mask





19. Then click on layer 2 and then do the same thing as above



20. After that tidy up their suburbs with the blur tool or press the R on the keyboard, and then poleskan. Completed.
