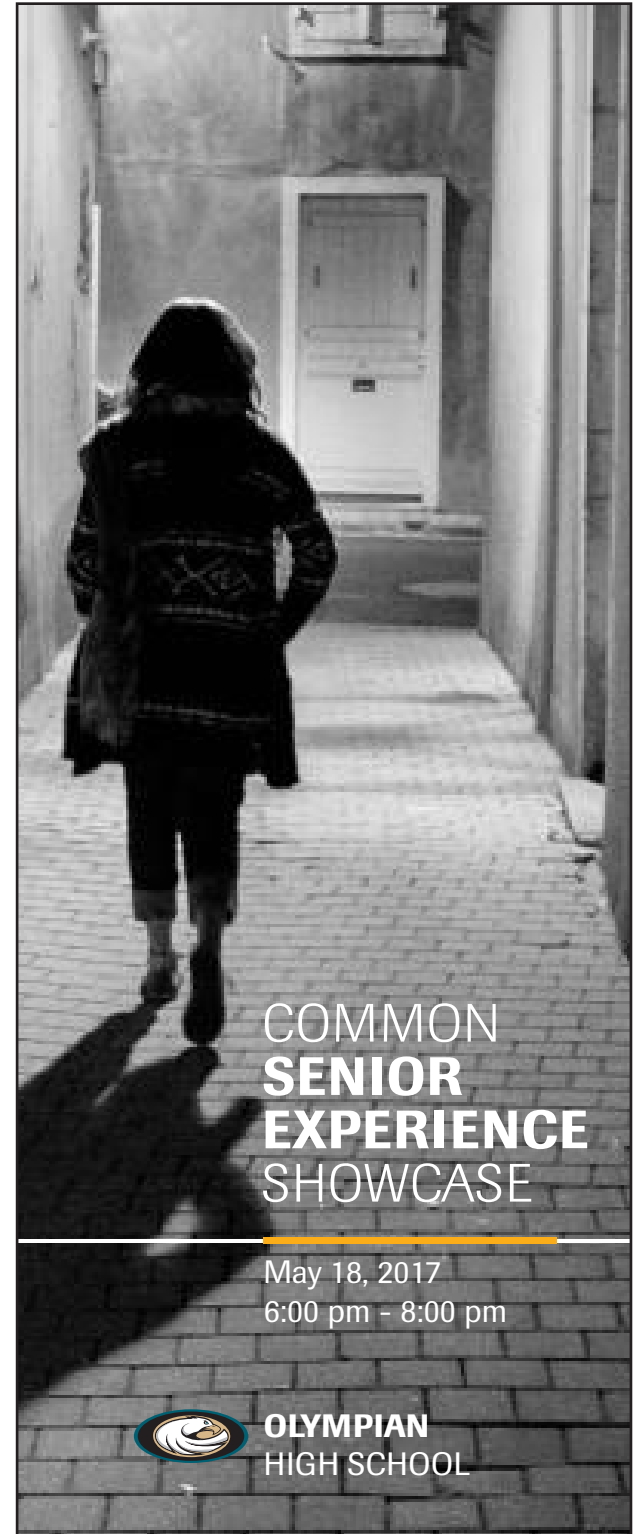


BOARD POLICY
