Equipment:

- All equipment will be checked out to students.
- Return the equipment in the same working condition, as it was when it was checked out to you.
- DO NOT change any of the computer settings (control Panels, Screensavers, Backgrounds, Set-up, ETC).
- DO NOT deface any hardware, furniture, Whiteboards or other school/classroom equipment.
- DO NOT share passwords with anyone.
- DO NOT TAMPER WITH: Hardware, software, keyboards, mouse, wires, screen, or internet cable.
- DO NOT Switch keyboards or mouse with another station. If something does not work, let the teacher know.
- DO NOT bring any files from home to download to the computer without teacher permission.
- DO NOT touch the computer screen. This will leave fingerprints and can ultimately damage the screen.
- DO NOT use printer without permission.

Procedures:

- At the start of class, each student will sign in at the teachers desk, or will be marked absent for the day.

- The last 2 minutes of class each day, each student will straighten the monitor, keyboard and mouse as well as push in the chair of the station before leaving.
