


<b>Feathering edges - Vignetting</b>		
1	Open portrait.jpg	
2	Make selection with <b>Elliptical Marquee</b> Tool around the head	
3	<b>Select &gt; Feather... 70</b>	
4	<b>Select &gt; Inverse</b>	
5	On keyboard use <b>D</b> and <b>X</b> key to switch between black and white. Set <b>background</b> to <b>white</b> .	
6	Hit <b>delete</b> key to delete selection to the background colour	
7	<b>Image &gt; Trim</b> - don't change any setting, and click <b>OK</b>	
8	<b>Select &gt; Deselect</b> or <b>Ctrl &gt; D</b>	
9	<b>File &gt; Revert</b> to go back to the last saved version	
10	What will happen if you repeat this exercise skipping step 2 (feathering)?	
11	Repeat exercise, but before hitting delete key (in step 3), change background colour to blue	
12	Change background color by using Eyedropper and selecting colour directly from image (eg. skin tone)
