STUDENT SHOWCASE – General Information

The Local and State Rules apply to this department, available at sdfair.com/entry. No entry will be accepted should the exhibitor describe conditions under which he/she will exhibit. The 22nd DAA (San Diego County Fair) will not be responsible for loss or damage of any kind.

ELIGIBILITY: Student projects made in schools in San Diego County, grades 7 through 12, Community Colleges, and ROP programs or Adult Education under the supervision of an instructor may be entered. Projects must have been finished during the 12-month period preceding the Fair. **See Creative Youth Department for individual youth, clubs or organizations not under the instruction of a teacher for ages 5-17. See Best of K-6 department for student projects K-6th grade.**

PROCESSING FEES: \$3.00 per entry. All group projects are \$10.00.

AWARDS: Ribbons are awarded. Best of Class will be awarded to the best exhibit in each class group (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7) in each Division. Each Best of Class winner will compete for a Best of Show Award in each Division. A Best of Show will be awarded for each class in Movies/Videos. No cash awards except where specified. Only the Best of Class and Best of Show winners will be listed on the website for viewing.

AWARDS RECEPTION: All Best of Class and Best of Show winners will be invited, along with their instructors, to attend an awards reception at the Fairgrounds. Winners will be notified by email. Each winner may invite a maximum of 3 guests to the awards ceremony.
